

Statement of Volatility – Alienware 27 280Hz Gaming Monitor – AW2726DL

The Alienware AW2726DL contains both volatile and non-volatile components. Volatile components erase their data immediately after power is removed from the component. Non-volatile components continue to retain their data even after power is removed from the component. The following non-volatile components are present on the Alienware AW2726DL system board.

Table 1. List of non-volatile components on system board

Description	Reference designator	Volatility description	User accessible for external data	Remedial action (action necessary to erase data)
System EEPROM	U403	Non-volatile memory, 32 KB for storage of system setting (OSD).	No	The part is installed on the Interface Board and is configured with both hardware and software-level write protection.
System Flash	U402	Non-volatile memory, 32 MB for storage of system firmware	No	The part is installed on the Interface Board and is configured with both hardware and software-level write protection.

⚠ CAUTION: All other components on the system board lose data if power is removed from the computer. Primary power loss (unplugging the power cable and removing the battery) destroys all user data on the memory. Secondary power loss (removing the on-board coin-cell battery) destroys system data on the system configuration and time-of-day information.
