

Statement of Volatility - Dell Pro 22 Adjustable Stand Monitor - E2226HS

The Dell E2226HS monitor contains both volatile and non-volatile (NV) components. Volatile components lose their data immediately after power is removed from the component. Non-volatile (NV) components continue to retain their data even after power is removed from the component. The following NV components are present on the E2226HS system board.

System EEPROM	U7	Non-volatile memory, 16 Kbit. For storage system setting.	No	Part place on interface board, it has hardware/software write protected.
System Flash ROM	U6	Non-volatile memory, 8 Mbit. For storage system firmware.	No	Part place on interface board, it has hardware/software write protected.
VGA EDID EEPROM	U4	Non-volatile memory, 2 Kbit. For storage VGA EDID data.	No	Part place on interface board, it has hardware/software write protected.
