GASKET AND GUIDE KIT

INSTALLATION

IMPORTANT NOTE

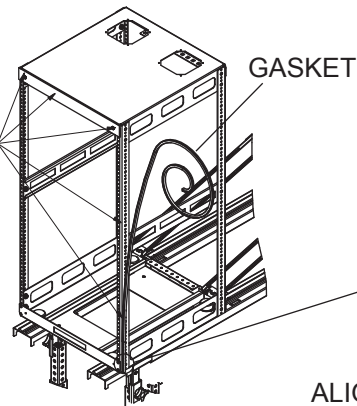
When using the gasket and guide kit, the minimum millwork rough opening width is 19-5/8"

INSTALL GASKET

- 1) When using the optional gasket to fill gaps between the rack and millwork, remove dust and debris from rack surface with included wipes.

- 2) Remove some of the paper backing from gasket and adhere gasket to bottom of rackrail where shown. Gently pull gasket up to top of rack while removing backing. Align gasket at top of rackrail and adhere. Press firmly along length of gasket. Continue across top and down opposite side of rack.

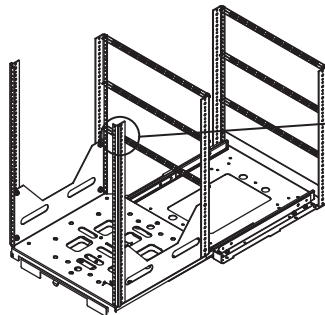

flanged panel)

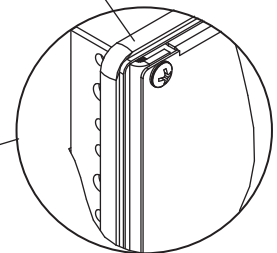

HINT: When installing gasket onto SRS or SRSR, place gasket on the sides of rackrail (see **FIGURE A**). If gasket is needed across the top of the rack, the top space will require a flanged panel or a component with a flat top. (see **FIGURE B**)

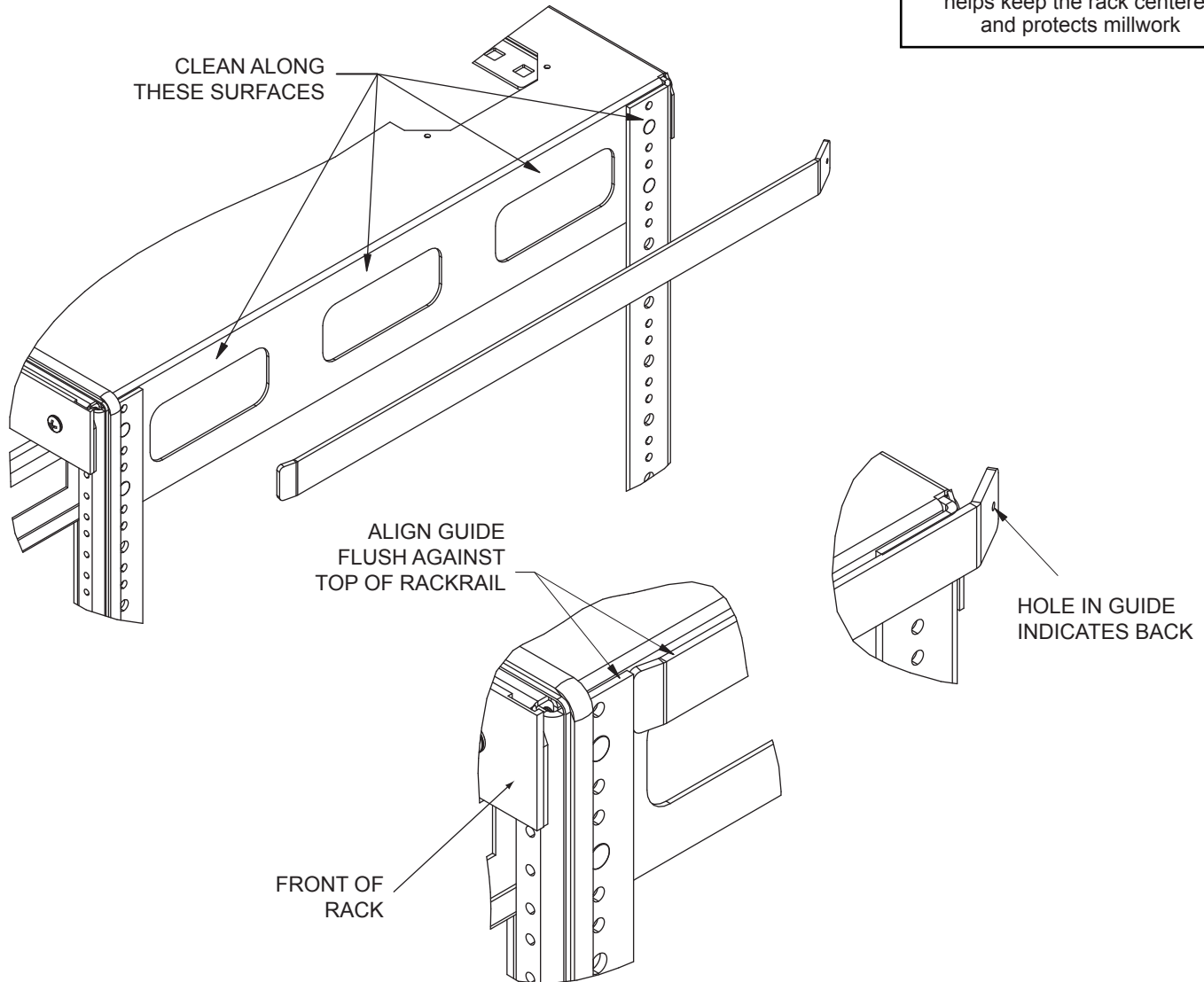
INSTALL GUIDE (If included in package)

- 1) When using optional guide kit to help keep the rack centered and protect millwork, remove dust and debris from rack surface with included wipes. Remove paper backing from adhesive and install guides as shown. Press firmly

DID YOU KNOW?

The guide and gasket kits may be used to enhance AXS, AX-SX, SAX, SSAX and AX-SXR enclosures

The gasket fills the gap between rack and millwork. The guide kit helps keep the rack centered and protects millwork



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
